Judging photojournalism Prints & Slides

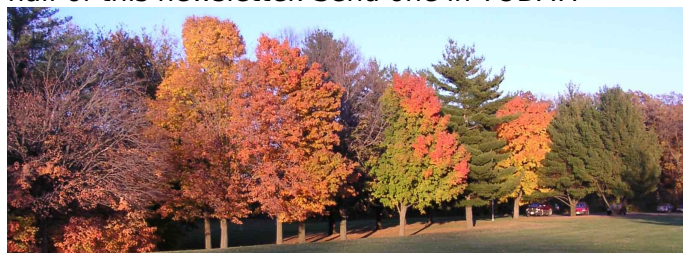
In October, our club was in charge of judging Photojournalism Prints & Slides for N4C. Since these are somewhat specialized categories, it was decided that we needed judges with particular expertise in this area. Dennis Chamberlin (who also judged the "WINTER" contest for us previously) an ISU Assistant Professor of Journalism, as well as Josh Harrell and Ross LaDue who are both Photo Editors for the Iowa State Daily agreed to be the judges. This was also a learning opportunity for their students who were invited to observe.

There were 39 slides from 12 participating clubs in the PJ Slides category, and 36 prints from 10 participating clubs in the Prints Category. We had entries from all 4 (N4C) states : Iowa, Minnesota, South Dakota and North Dakota.

N4C Photo Contests

There is a contest each month. One entry per person and 8 entries per club for each category listed below. Send your photos (except for digital) to **Denise Wheeler** (232-3521) by the 5th of month.

The categories are:

1. 2 x 2 pictorial slides (35 mm art).
2. 2 x 2 nature slides.
3. Black & white pictorial prints, large and small (judged separately).
Large prints = mount up to 16 x 20 inches.
Small prints = mount up to 11 x 14 inches (usually an 8 x 10 print).
4. Nature prints, large and small.
5. 2 1/4 slides (i.e. medium format).
6. Color prints, large and small (any topic).
7. Contemporary/creative prints & slides (weird or manipulated).
8. Photojournalism prints & slides (prints may be small, mounted and must not be matted).
9. Travel prints & slides.
- 10 & 11. Two digital contests, pictorial and nature. The images must be 1024 x 768 or smaller, less than 500 kb of memory and in jpg format. Submit these to: rbpearce@mchsi.com by the 10th of the month.
